For all personal property, except a manufactured or mobile home, a date not less than the earlier of 30 days after delivery of this notice or 33 days after the date of mailing of this notice, or for manufactured or mobile home, a date that is not less than the earlier of 75 days after delivery of this notice or 78 days after the date of mailing this notice, or the personal property will be sold or otherwise disposed.

If the abandoned property is not removed:

- Your landlord may sell the property at a public or private sale; or
- Your landlord may destroy or otherwise dispose of the property if the landlord reasonably believes that the value of the property is so low that the cost of storage and conducting a public sale would probably exceed the amount that would be realized from the sale; or
- Your landlord may sell items of value and destroy or otherwise dispose of the remaining property.

If you claim the property within the time provided by this notice, your landlord must make the property available for removal by you without payment of any unpaid rent.
