Please note that this date will not be less than 30 days after the date the written notice was mailed, or not less than 60 days after the date the written notice was mailed if the Tenant has notified the Landlord in writing that he or she is on active duty in the armed forces of the United States.

If the personal property is not removed within the time provided for above, then the Tenant forfeits his or her ownership rights to the personal property and the personal property becomes the property of the Landlord.

Please also note that if the personal property is worth more than \$300.00 and is not removed from the property or place of safekeeping within the time period stated above, your Landlord will store the personal property for up to 30 additional days if the Tenant or any person holding a security interest in the abandoned personal property informs the Landlord of their intent to remove the property: Provided, that the Tenant or person holding a security interest in the abandoned personal property pays the Landlord the reasonable costs of storage and removal.
